

Splash is formulated as an application fluid concentrate, designed to aid in the application of pressure sensitive vinyl films and graphics. It allows for repositioning and removal of trapped air, by acting as a buffer between the film adhesive and the surface until it is squeegeed out from beneath the film or graphic.



Directions for Use

- Combine the contents (8 fluid ounces) of one container of Splash with 120 ounces of water in clean mixing vessel and stir slowly and thoroughly.
- Move this mixture into an atomizing spray bottle for use.
- Spray Splash onto the adhesive side of pressure sensitive vinyl films and/or onto the clean surface to which they will be applied.
- Do not use on films or applications in which the film manufacturer specifies a "dry" application.
- Use a vinyl graphics application squeegee to remove fluid and trapped air from beneath the film prior to removing the application tape.
- On larger graphics, applying Splash to the surface of the application tape itself, post application, can aid in tape removal.
- Use a clean, dry cloth to remove excess Splash from the area after removing application tape.
- Prevent from freezing.
